# Types of Taxes on Products

- Sales Tax Applied to goods/services at the point of sale
- Value-Added Tax (VAT) Applied at each stage of production and sale
- Excise Tax Levied on specific goods (e.g., alcohol, tobacco)
- Customs Duties Applied to imported goods
